NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON TAX INCREASE

A tax rate of \$0.1000 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of Parker County Emergency Services District No. 3 ("ESD#3").

PROPOSED TAX RATE	\$0.100000 PER \$100
NO-NEW-REVENUE RATE	\$0.095160 PER \$100
VOTER-APPROVAL TAX RATE	\$0.098550 PER \$100

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2024 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for ESD#3 from the same properties in both the 2023 tax year and 2024 tax year.

The voter-approval rate is the highest tax rate that ESD#3 may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate, unless the de minimis rate for ESD#3 exceeds the voter-approval rate for ESD#3.

The de minimis rate is the rate equal to the sum of the no-new-revenue maintenance and operations rate for ESD#3, the rate that will raise \$500,000.00 and the current debt rate for ESD#3.

The proposed tax rate is greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that ESD#3 is proposing to increase the taxes for the 2024 tax year.

A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON August 22, 2024 at 9:00 am at 2110 Fort Worth Highway, Weatherford, Texas 76086.

The proposed tax rate is greater than the voter-approval tax rate but not greater than the de minimis rate and does not exceed the rate that allows voters to petition for an election under Section 26.075, Tax Code. If ESD#3 adopts the proposed tax rate, ESD#3 is not required to hold an election so that the voters may accept or reject the proposed tax rate and the qualified voters of the ESD#3 may not petition the ESD#3 to require and election to be held to determine whether to reduce the proposed tax rate.

The 86th Texas Legislature modified the manner in which the voter-approval tax rate is calculated to limit the rate of growth of property taxes in the state.
